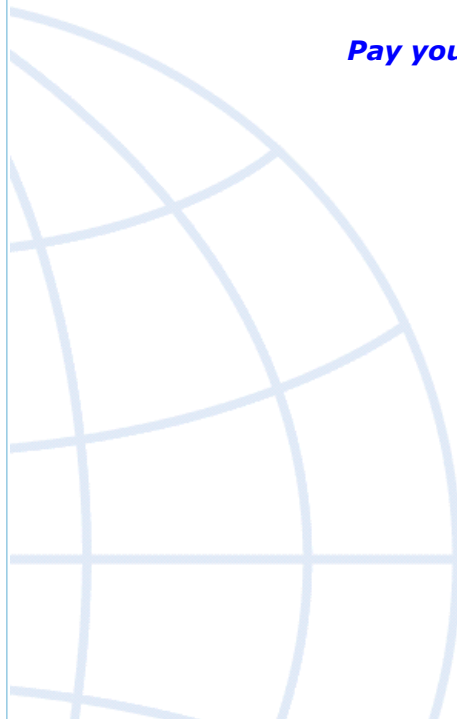

About FEE

The Foundation for Environmental Education (FEE) is a non-governmental and non-profit organisation aiming to promote sustainable development through environmental education.

FEE is mainly active through five environmental education programmes: Blue Flag, Eco-Schools, Young Reporters for the Environment, Learning About Forests, and The Green key.

FEE is an international umbrella organisation with one national member organisation per country representing FEE on the national level and in charge of implementing FEE programmes nationally. As of June 2009, FEE has member organisations in 59 countries in Europe, North and South America, Africa, Asia and Oceania.

The vision of the Learning About Forests (LEAF) Programme is to see an increased level of awareness and knowledge about the key role forests play for sustainable life on our planet. The Programme will reflect all the functions forests fulfill for people; cultural, ecological, economical and social. CO₂ Compensation Fund

About the CO₂ Compensation Fund

As FEE is an international organisation working for promoting sustainable development, we have decided to establish a general compensation of the CO₂ emission from all our international flight travels. Persons, companies and institutions outside can contribute to the Fund as well.



By using the CO₂ Fund you support tree planting activities in schools involved in the environmental education programmes of FEE (LEAF, Eco-Schools and YRE). Tree planting must be combined with environmental education activities for enhancing childrens' understanding of climate change issues.

Schools from countries outside the FEE network can also apply for funding from the CO₂ Fund. Documents with application form and application procedure can be downloaded from the FEE website.

Paying to the CO₂ Compensation Fund

You can pay compensation of the CO₂ emission from your flights via the FEE website. If you do not know the distance between your city of departure and city of arrival, you can find it via the "Geobytes City Distance Tool" on the FEE's CO₂ webpage.

In the FEE Donation Shop you can buy either around 15,000 km for €50 (intercontinental flight) or around 3,000 km for €10 (continental flight). If you wish to see the calculation method, you can find the details on the FEE website.
